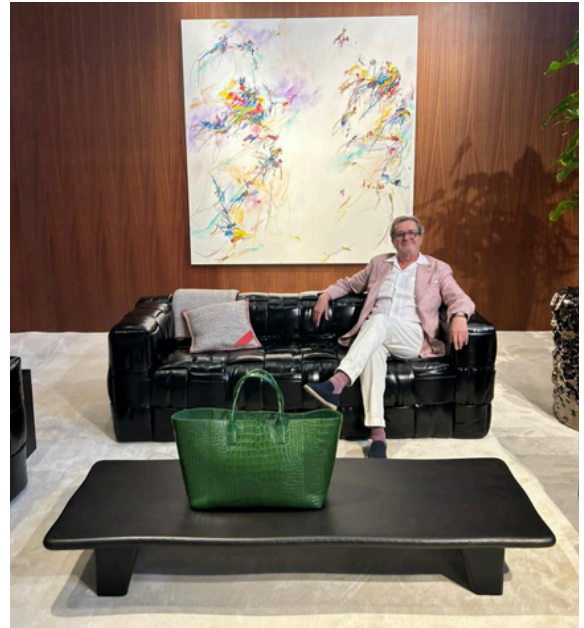


## Numeraire Future Trends Partners with Esteemed Dubai Collector Charles Al Sidaoui to Safeguard and Future-Proof His Collection

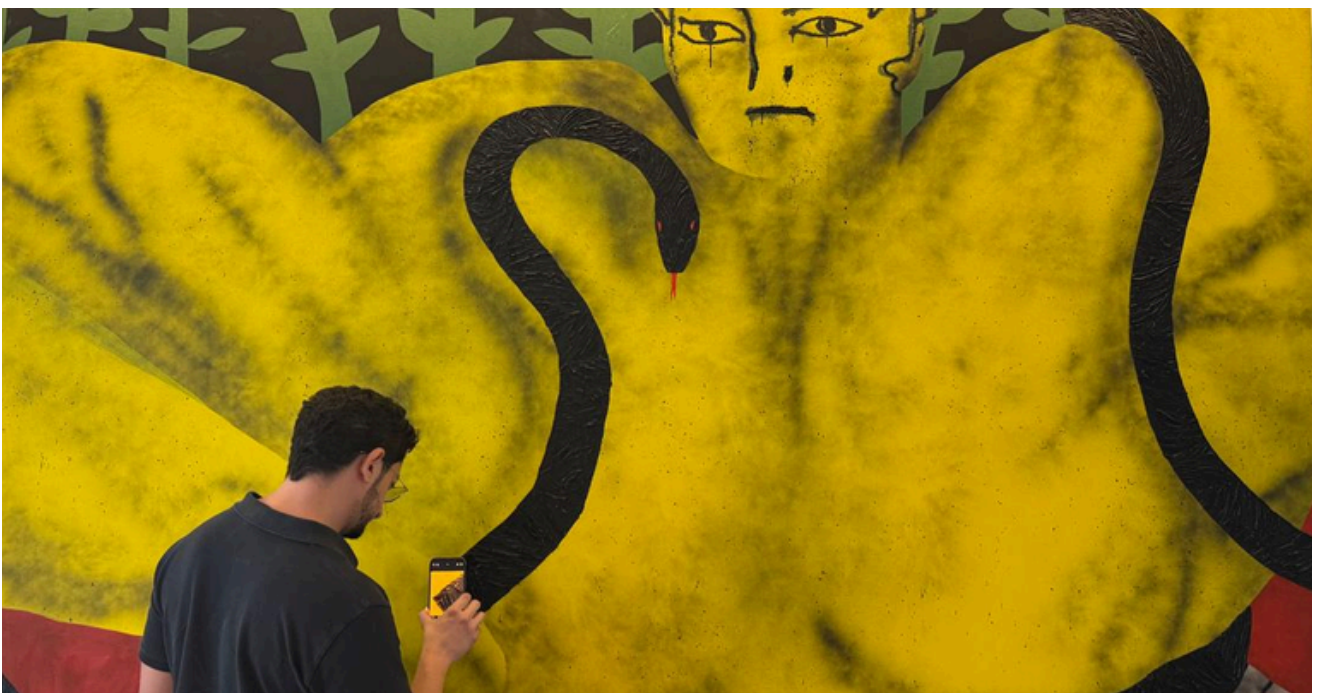
